- The committee has the authority to assign and/or change booth assignment positions.
- The committee is not responsible for injury or accident.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed to be sold or consumed within the Block Party or its immediate vicinity.
- All participants must provide their own set-ups and/or equipment.
- Set-up begins at 2 p.m. — tear down is at 11 p.m. If using a booth or canopy, these may not exceed the assigned area. NO equipment is provided by the Block Party.
- No pull-tab (instant tickets) booths are allowed.
- All food vendors must comply with the Greene County Health Department regulations and obtain the necessary certificates. For information and certificates, you may contact them at (937) 427-2883.
- Water is not available All cooking wastes (grease, bones, etc.) must be removed by the vendor.
- Complete entries with full payment received before June 1, 2009, will be guaranteed last year’s spot.
- Payment for space must be received with application before June 19, 2009. There will be a \$10 late fee if not received by June 19, 2009. No refunds will be given for cancellation of event due to inclement weather.
- Roadway must be cleared by 11:30 p.m. or subject to tow.
